

DISPUTE OVER SEVERED GILL CONNECTIONS

Today, at the Australian Anglers Association's National Championships, a dispute arose over the length a fish with severed gill connections had to be, to be acceptable for weigh-in.

Following a meeting of all the State Captains, it was decided that all fish weighed in with severed gill connections for the remainder of this carnival, had to measure 3cm above the State legal length.

All competitors need to be aware of this ruling to avoid incurring a penalty.
